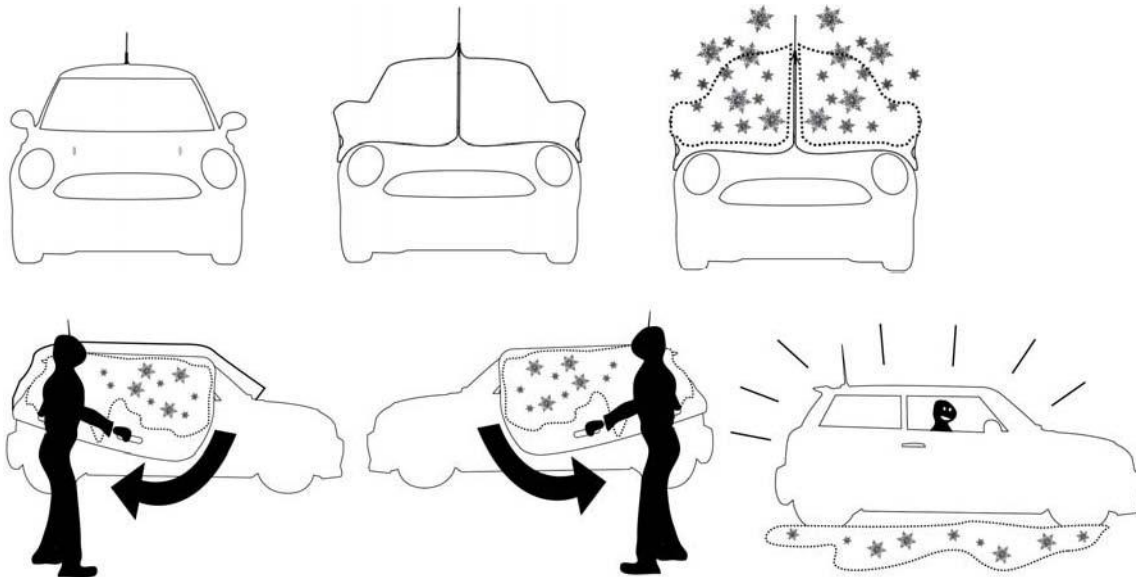


Instructions for Auto Snow Shield Use

Placing the cover on your vehicle:

- Step 1. Before placing the Auto Snow Shield on your vehicle attach one side of the cover to the other via the hook and loop strips found on the inside section of both vertical fins. Make sure each fin is lined up to the other evenly.
- Step 2. With the vertical fins attached to each other, lay one side of the Auto Snow Shield flat over the other so it can be carried to and placed on the vehicle.
- Step 3. Lay the folded Auto Snow Shield over half of the vehicle and then pull the folded half of the cover over the other side of the vehicle.
- Step 4. Once the Auto Snow Shield is unfurled over the vehicle make sure the vertical fin is in an upright position and is centered in the midline of the vehicle.
- Step 5. Once you're satisfied with the positioning of the Snow Shield, use the tie-downs, located by the handles and the four corners of the cover, to hook onto the vehicle. The tie-downs located by the handles can attach to the bottom of the vehicle while the one located at the four corners of the cover can attach to the wheels or wheel wells of the vehicle.

***Note: The tie-downs use flexible hooks which can be "bent" around any part of a vehicle which is convenient for securing the cover.**



Cleaning Instructions

Auto Snow Shield should be kept clean by wiping material with a clean damp cloth. Do not put Auto Snow Shield in the washing machine or dryer as damage to the unit may occur.

Disclaimer Information:

1. Do not place the Auto Snow Shield on dirty vehicles; doing so may result in scratching of

vehicle.

Disclaimer Information (cont.):

- 1 Keep the Auto Snow Shield free from abrasive contaminants by cleaning it after each use.
- 2 While not using, store the Auto Snow Shield in a clean dry place.
- 3 If your vehicle is wet before you place the Auto Snow Shield on your vehicle it may create traction between the Snow Shield and the surface of your vehicle which makes repositioning of the cover difficult.
- 4 Do not place the Auto Snow Shield on a vehicle which is already wet from precipitation; doing so may cause the Snow Shield to freeze to your vehicle under certain condition. If this occurs, before removing the Snow Shield from your vehicle, place your hand under the cover to separate it where it's frozen to the surface of the vehicle.
- 5 The Auto Snow Shield is not a traditional vehicle cover and is therefore not intended to be placed on a vehicle for extended periods of time. Please remove the Auto Snow Shield from your vehicle after each storm.
- 6 Do not attempt to move or drive vehicle with Auto Snow Shield installed. Doing so may cause injury to yourself or another or may cause damage to your vehicle or another's vehicle or property.
